Dear Parents/Carers

To enhance our topic on Trains and Victorians next half term, we are planning a trip to The Manchester Museum of Science and Industry on **Tuesday 14th November**. We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 9:15 and returning before the end of the school day.

At the Museum there are a lot of galleries and activities that explore transport (including trains) and the Victorian era. We will be visiting the Power Hall where there are a large collection of engines and locomotives that we can explore. In this building we will attend a pre-booked workshop 'Engineer Evan's Difficult Day', which is an interactive session where students can learn how a steam train works and get to see it's difficult parts moving

We will also have an engine demonstration, where an Explainer will demonstrate an engine moving and explain how it helped people back in the Victorian era. If time allows we will also visit the 'Revolution Manchester Show' which explores the Industrial Revolution in Manchester.

The cost of the visit will be £7.50 payable via ParentPay by Monday 6th November, this will also be your consent for your child to go on the trip.

Children on school dinners will have a packed lunch provided for them by school, the rest of the children will need to provide their own packed lunch in a named plastic bag for ease of disposal. Please avoid using any reusable lunch boxes and drinks bottles.

We have a limited number of places available for adult helpers so if you are available and would like to assist on the trip please contact your child's teacher A.S.A.P. so we can finalise arrangements.
